Alteration of the name of State of Mysore as the State of Karnataka—changes to be made in letter head etc.—instructions relating to—

- READ—(1) Circular No. GAD 44 PLX 73 dated 10th August 1973  
(2) Notification No. LAW 37 L A 73 dated 9th October 1973  
(3) Notification No. LAW 83 LCR 73 dated 11th October 1973

PREAMBLE—

In circular No. GAD 44 PLX 73 dated 10th August 1973 instructions have been given regarding the action to be taken for effecting alterations in the letter heads, seals, rubber stamps etc., consequent upon the change of the name of the State of Mysore as State of K. R. P. K. The Mysore State (Alteration of Name) Act, 1973 (Central Act 31 of 1973) was assented to by the President of India and has been republished in the Mysore Gazette Extraordinary dated 12th October 1973. The said Act will come into force with effect from 1st November 1973.

ORDER No. GAD 9 DFE 73, BANGALORE, DATED 20TH OCTOBER 1973

Since the name of the State of Mysore will become State of Karnataka with effect from the 1st November 1973, it is hereby directed that action as already requested in the circular mentioned above may be taken expeditiously for substituting the words "Government of Karnataka" in the place of "Government of Mysore" occurring in the crests of Government Buildings, name plates of Vehicles, Letter heads, Forms etc.

The Secretaries to Government and Heads of Departments are required to issue suitable instructions to the Officers concerned to get from the Director of Printing, Stationery and Publications, Bangalore the required rubber stamps, seals, letter heads etc. with the necessary change in the name of the State.

Sanction is accorded to the expenditure to be incurred in this behalf.
